#### Act on the Strengthening of the Financial Market Integrity

New rules designed to bolster both the internal (in particular, via the supervisory board) and external (e.g., by strengthening the independence of external auditors and their supervision) corporate governance of companies of public interest, including listed companies. Learn More »
